

St Luke's Anglican Church, Mosman Organist and Director of Music Position Overview

St Luke's, Mosman is seeking to appoint a new Organist and Director of Music. This position is a part time permanent position calculated as equivalent to 1.5 days (12 hours) per week. The current remuneration is \$20,000 p.a. plus statutory superannuation. Commencement date by negotiation, however, a commencement in mid-September 2023 would be preferable.

The primary objective of this position is to establish, foster and maintain a high standard of traditional Anglican organ and choral music within the Parish. The position will involve the administration of the Parish music ministry, including but not limited to, the training and nurturing of choristers, choral scholars and musicians with the aim of enhancing the worship of the Parish.

This is an opportunity for an established organist to undertake an expansive role and develop their skills in a supportive environment. St Luke's Mosman is a progressive community that welcomes all people regardless of gender, age, or sexual orientation.

The Parish's main Sunday service is currently a 9.00 a.m. Sung Eucharist. The role is responsible for rehearsing the choir prior to and playing the organ at the Sunday Eucharist. In addition, the successful candidate will become a Member of the Executive Committee of the St Luke's Mosman Music Association Inc. to advise on and coordinate an annual program of concerts.
